The raindate will be Sunday, October 4th. Grotonfest is a free, annual festival encompassing music, the arts, area businesses and non-profit groups, now in its 37th year.

A well-known event that draws thousands to this historic town, Grotonfest has often been featured as a “pick” in the Boston Globe. Continuous entertainment will feature a wealth of local talent including Mumblefish, Wendy Frank and Seth Connolly, 8 Amp Fuse, the Center Stage Dancers, and much more still to be finalized (complete schedule will be announced on our website at [www.grotonfest.com](http://www.grotonfest.com)).

12' X 12' spaces are available for artists and craftspeople at a rate of \$95.00. A limited number of booths will be available at no charge for those interested in providing demonstrations of their craft throughout the day. If you wish to be considered for this opportunity please check the appropriate space below. (your check will be returned if accepted as a demonstrator.)  
All work must be handmade with no outside manufacturing or imports allowed.

Artisans are expected to bring their own displays, tables, canopies etc. Set up begins at 7:00 a.m. and we must stress the importance of allowing plenty of time to set up. And keep in mind that this is a family event- you may do well to offer a few lesser expensive wares along with your high-end items. Also, we can provide electricity for a very limited number of booths, so apply early if you'd like us to try to accommodate your request (preference will be given to craft demonstrators).

Please enclose at least 3 photos or slides of your work and/or booth (for jurying as well as promotional purposes) and a S.A.S.E. for their return. Grotonfest is well advertised through local and regional media and we will welcome any opportunity to showcase your work in our promotion of the festival.
